RAYS - Straight Talk

with His Holiness Jagadguru
Sri Sri Sri Dr. Nirmalanandanatha Mahaswamiji

The most awaited and key highlight segment of PRERANA – RAYS – Straight Talk with His Holiness Jagadguru Sri Sri Sri Dr. Nirmalanandanatha

Mahaswamiji was hosted by Dr. B J Mahendra, Director of Mandya Institute of Medical Sciences & Alumni of Adichunchanagiri Institute of Medical Sciences.

Before he began his talk, he emphasized the significance of the Vedas, stating that they are considered the very breathing air of God and preach about the well-being of society. Personally, I believe that hearing the Vedas purifies us. Inspired by the four Vedas, we named our talk "RAYS" – with each letter representing a different Veda – Rig Veda, Atharva Veda, Yajur Veda, and Sama Veda. We chose this name with the belief that the RAYS talk would purify our thinking, mindset, thought process, and attitude towards ourselves and society.

The session was insightful with the words of Paramapoojya Mahaswamiji. During the Session, Paramapoojya Mahaswamiji shared the essence of the Mantra "Jai Sri Gurudev" stating that Jai Sri Gurudev, is a compound word Jai, one word, Sri, and Gurudev are two different words. Jai means Victory, triumph, and success. Sri is a Lakshmi, Prosperity, not only with respect to Money, but also Richness of Knowledge, Enlightenment, Realization, Prosperity, and Progress. Sri symbolizes all these meanings.

Again, when you come down to Gurudev, it's a compound word. If you split Guru & Dev, Guru is a Spiritual Teacher or a Teacher. When it comes to the spiritual domain, a Guru will become a spiritual teacher or a Spiritual Master. When a Student becomes a Disciple, then we can call him a Master, or if he is a Mundane Student, then we can call him a Teacher, and then he will become Divine.



All put together, it is understood that a man or the person who is the embodiment of the Divine, who is the realized Master, who is going to be helpful to the student to make his life quite successful & with which successful person he is going to be equipped and endowed and blessed with all the richness of the world, be it a spiritual richness or the mundane, one who is going to make a disciple, can be addressed as Jai Sri Gurudev.

When we face the person who has given us all these things, "Jai Sri Gurudev" is the best way to greet. It is the best tribute one can express towards Guru. that is the reason why we have coined phrase "Jai Sri Gurudev".

During the continuous conversation Paramapoojya Jagadguru Sri Sri Sri Dr. Nirmalanandanatha

Mahaswamiji also shared the impact and influence of Sri Sri Sri Dr. Balagangadharanatha

Mahaswamiji on him stating that "As a young chap, when I submitted myself to Poojya Guruji Sri Sri Sri Dr.

Balagangadharanatha Mahaswamiji, he trained me in such a way, as a Sanyasi, if one wants to live in the midst of the worldly society, such a person should be well equipped with both mundane and the eternal.

When I say the mundane, he should have the knowledge of Living in society. At the same time, we should know, we should not be derived from the spiritual life also. When you decide to render service to society, if you start living only the mundane life, there will not be any difference between the mundane person and the spiritual person.

If the mundane should be well equipped with strong values a person like me should have spiritual values and just not knowing the values, rather you should be a practicing person. These are the two things that Poojya Guruji Sri Sri Sri Dr. Balagangadharanatha Mahaswamiji has told me.

On one side, you should be equipped with the best of the best knowledge of the world like Science, Mathematics, and whatnot, all the best worldly knowledge. At the same time, as a substratum, Adistana, spiritual knowledge also should be there. These are the two things that Poojya Guruji Sri Sri Sri Dr. Balagangadharanatha Mahaswamiji has emphasized. The need to inculcate the same with which we can rise to a greater height, with which we can render service to society.

In that sense, my Poojya Guruji Sri Sri Dr. Balagangadharanatha Mahaswamiji, himself was the epitome of all these. On one side, he was a great learned, worldly scholar, because he himself was a B.Sc. Science with scientific knowledge. At the same time, he was not just a spiritual understanding personality. According to me, he himself was a great realized personality, a realized being like a Buddha. Because he knew both the inner and the outer. He wanted to induct and inculcate the same thing in me also."

Paramapoojya Jagadguru Sri Sri Dr. Nirmalanandanatha Mahaswamiji rested his address recalling his Love and respect towards the institutions where he studied and gave a message to the Alumni of Adichunchanagiri Institute of Medical Sciences stating that "As an Sanyasi if I could love my college so much, you, people, are not Sanyasis, how much love you should

have towards this Rural Medical College- Adichunchanagiri Institute of Medical Sciences, B G Nagara which has given so much life and abundant energy to you all. Dr. A P J Abdul Kalam used to tell the community that there is an institution called Adichunchanagiri Institute of Medical Sciences 100 km away from Bangalore which has been rendering enormous service to society. It was on his mind. He was dreaming quite a lot for this institution.

But most of you people have never asked what you can be responsible for in elevating the problems of the area and elevating the greatness of this institution. I would rather request you all as a servant of mankind, to come together and render service over here. Alumini - senior students are not just senior students you are the past you are the present and you are going to be the future.

If a person has graduated and is employed and starts earning do you think that humble family is going to remain forever as it is? It is going to be progressive. Economically, it is going to be strong, intellectually, it is going to be elevated, and with respect to social status, it is going to be respected by one another. If one person can bring such glory to one humble family, so many of you have graduated from this prestigious institution and have become great doctors, why should you think that this institution should have remained a small institution? If it still remaining as an unknown obscure institution, then each one of you should feel responsible as an Alumni of this Institution.

Eventually, only when you people contribute your knowledge and service to this institution, it is going to be respected. Similarly, if students would say I am going to join AIMS then you all are going to get great Happiness, won't you?

To make that possible, please join your hands and share your knowledge with great amalgamation and understanding in sharing the knowledge and rendering helping hands for the poor people.
